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AHCCCS ONLINE TARGETED INVESTMENTS 2.0 APPLICATION PORTAL

The AHCCCS Online Targeted Investments 2.0 Application Portal is now open:

- Organizations (TINs) **only** applying for BH and/or Justice: 9/1/2023 - 10/20/2023
- Organizations applying for Primary Care: 9/12/2023 - 10/20/2023

Documents that do not meet all requirements will be rejected. Applications without sufficient documentation will be denied.

<p>TI 2.0 Justice Commitment Letter/ Application Template</p>	<p>One per clinic applying to the TIP 2.0 Justice Program signed by the provider CEO or equivalent AND the clinic's justice partner(s).</p>
<p>TI Authorized User Agreement Form</p>	<p>One per organization signed by a CEO or project manager directly employed by the organization. The signatory is responsible for the accuracy of each attestation and serves as the primary point of contact for payment-related information and post-pay audits. Additional individuals privy to payment-related information can be added at the bottom of the form.</p>

APPLICATION ASSISTANCE

- AHCCCS will not allow TI 2.0 applicants to correct submitted policies and procedures after the application deadline. AHCCCS strongly encourages applicants to participate in the Application Document Review process to identify missing elements and correct policies and procedures before submitting the application.
- Application Document Review is available on a first-come, first-served basis. AHCCCS will provide instructions to organizations that request assistance via [provider interest form](#) before 9/15/2023. AHCCCS will stop accepting documents for review on October 6, 2023 at 5 p.m.
- TI will demonstrate the AHCCCS Online TI 2.0 Application Portal at the 9/8 Information Session - [register here](#). A recording will be published to the website as soon as possible.

- If an applicant needs to change a submitted application prior to the application deadline, email a request to the AHCCCS Targeted Investments team to reopen the TIN's application. Once reopened, the application must be resubmitted before the application deadline.

PROVIDER ENROLLMENT MORATORIUM

- AHCCCS has paused enrollment of new 77s, ICs and 01-group billers, and revoked the ability to add additional service addresses. Applicants may only select from actively enrolled clinics in the AHCCCS Online Targeted Investments 2.0 Application Portal. Steps to include affected clinics in the TI 2.0 application vary:

<p>PCP only- The organization has some, but not all, PCP clinics enrolled with AHCCCS under an IC or an 01-group service address.</p>	<p>1. The entire address must match NPPES and/or other clinic directories (e.g., Google).</p> <p>3. Complete and submit the application.</p> <p>4. PCP- PROVIDER ENROLLMENT

- All PCP organizations must update AHCCCS and Health Plans with physician (MD, DO, NP) information:
 - Active/ terminated employment status,
 - Tax ID affiliation,
 - Service address(es), and
 - Provider specialty(ies).
- Organizations with more than one non-licensed clinic must:
 - **CMS NPPES:** Request a new NPI from CMS for each non-licensed clinic service address. This is a different NPI than those affiliated with any physicians (e.g., MD, DO) or 01-group billing IDs.
 - **AHCCCS Online Application:** Enter the clinic NPI and matching service address in the PCP “Provider Selection” page.
