
The Arizona Health Care Cost Containment System (AHCCCS), Division of Health Care Management (DHCM), reviewed and accepted UnitedHealthcare Community Plan's (UHCCP) Corrective Action Plan (CAP). The CAP was imposed as a result of the Notice to Cure (NTC) levied against UHCCP due to violation of its Acute Care contract YH14-0001 and its Children's Rehabilitative Services (CRS) contract YH14-0002, for contract year ending 2015, involving the provision of systems and data exchange requirements and encounter data reporting.

UHCCP has complied with the requirements of the NTC including submission and implementation of a corrective action plan outlining specific items addressed in the NTC.

Based on the above, UHCCP has fulfilled the NTC requirements as outlined in the Acute Care contract YH14-001 and the CRS contract YH14-0002 for the contract year ending 2015. As such, UHCCP is no longer required to submit weekly reports and is released from this NTC. However, AHCCCS will continue to monitor UHCCP for continued compliance with these and all other Encounter related provisions, any further non-compliance may result in additional compliance actions.
