2.	Devoted Guardians			On the EVV DAP, it would really be helpful to have this DAP back up to 1%. It was cut to .5% this year, and we are seeing this is not enough to cover our costs. The administrative burden is enormous related to EVV and we haven't even started yet. We almost need 2 full time headcounts to manage the process. We also need funds to help cover some EVV software costs and device costs for members who do not have access.
