Thank you for your recent letter requesting information about the Medicaid portion of the Health Information Technology (HIT) incentive program from the Arizona Health Care Cost Containment System. AHCCCS received approval from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) in January to initiate planning on how the agency will meet the goals of the program.

As you know, much of the details of the incentive program are still under consideration by CMS, but we plan on posting any new developments to the HIT webpage on the AHCCCS website. It is our plan to use the web to post information related to HIT including agency's comments regarding meaningful use, federal and state health information technology resources, points of contact and any public information opportunities that become available. All of the incentive information is listed under the Health Information Technology tab at www.azahcccs.gov.

The agency will be using the next several months to develop its proposed methods and strategies for achieving meaningful use for Medicaid providers and hospitals, based on the proposed rules. Our goal is to have our state Medicaid Health Information Technology Plan submitted to CMS by the summer. As we begin this process, we will keep the Indian Health Service facilities and tribal health programs operated under P.L. 93-638 apprised of AHCCCS activities regarding HIT and involve those facilities that may be eligible for Medicaid incentive payments.
