


Dual Eligible Members

Are you looking for a simpler way to manage your healthcare with both Medicare and Medicaid?

AHCCCS is Arizona's State Medicaid Program. AHCCCS Members who also have Medicare are called Dual Eligible Members. Being enrolled in the same health plan for Medicare and Medicaid is called "alignment."

Alignment provides:

- One plan that coordinates all care.
- A comprehensive provider network.
- · Timely coordination of care.
- · Reduced confusion for members and providers.
- Easier access to specialists who are contracted with both Medicare and Medicaid.
- · Better health outcomes.



How do I know if I am in an aligned health plan?

Call your AHCCCS health plan Member Services telephone number (on your member ID card) to find out if your Medicare and Medicaid health plans are aligned.

How do I align my Medicare and Medicaid health plans?

All Dual Eligible Members may have opportunities to change their Medicare Advantage health plan enrollment, including D-SNP, a minimum of four times per year.

Dual Eligible members have several options to receive Medicare services:

- D-SNP (D-Special Needs Plan) a type of Medicare Advantage Plan contracted with AHCCCS that is available only to AHCCCS Dual Eligibles. D-SNP plans offer attractive supplemental benefits such as dental and vision.
- · Other Medicare Advantage Plans.
- · Traditional Medicare.

Many Dual Eligible Members have different health plans for Medicaid and Medicare and may have complex health needs which may be better served by a D-SNP plan that can offer more coordinated benefits and support. Dual Eligible Members may contact their clinical team, or their Medicare Advantage Health Plan if enrolled, to determine whether they are enrolled in an aligned health plan, and how to change health plans if desired. Choice of another Medicare Advantage Health Plan or Traditional Medicare is available if a specific provider is unavailable in a specific D-SNP plan.
