

# FAMILY-RUN ORGANIZATIONS PROVIDING CHILDREN'S SERVICES

As the caregiver of a biological, foster, kinship or adopted child, you have covered services available at no cost to you from many different agencies. Some of these agencies are family-run organizations.

#### What is a Family-Run Organization?

Family-run organizations employ parents who have real life experience in the behavioral, medical and/or DCS systems. They specialize in providing family support services, and can provide one-on-one support to you.



#### **Family Support Services Can Help You:**

- Know that you are not alone
- Navigate the child serving systems
- Locate services/resources that are the "right fit" for the needs of the child and family
- Learn to be an advocate
- Gain new skills to care for your child
- · Identify formal and informal support systems
- Develop a service plan
- Manage hospital discharge planning

- Feel supported during Child and Family team meetings (CFT), Foster Care Review Boards (FCRB) and court hearings
- Keep things consistent in your child's care when case managers or therapists change
- Understand decision letters, and how to submit appeals
- Help you deal with agency's that are not supportive of the needs of your child
- Find classes, trainings, support groups and more

#### How to Access Services from a Family-Run Organization

- 1. Choose one of the family-run providers.
- 2. Ask your child's Case Manager to add "Family Support Services" provided by the family-run organization of your choice to your child's service plan. You have the right to receive services from the provider of YOUR choice.
