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## suspense/reinstatement with Juvenile Court System

- ADC recent request for clarification re IGAs, MOUs and BAs for reach-in-Note: Business Agreements not necessary as part of reach-in process
- Consents signed while in Jail-Pend for future discussion
- H.R. 1329: the Medicaid Reentry Act allows for 30 day Medicaid coordination for incarcerated members-FYI
- Approach for supporting inmates aged 18-20 who will now stay in the Juvenile system-Justice liaisons will work with ADC to ensure continuity of care.
- Targeted Investments

  - o Upcoming TI Justice forums- June 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup>
