




INCARCERATED INDIVIDUALS

ELIGIBILITY v ENROLLMENT



INCARCERATED ADULTS



- 12 of the 15 Arizona counties and the Arizona Department of Corrections have Intergovernmental Agreements (IGA) with AHCCCS for Enrollment Suspense
- Electronic file sent daily to AHCCCS which includes a list of all individuals who were:
 - Incarcerated (minimum 24 hours & IA)
 - Released
- AHCCCS processes the file to identify current Medicaid recipients and either suspends or reinstates enrollment
- Eligibility is not effected by this process

HANDLING OF ELECTRONIC FILE DISCREPANCIES

- Partial Match report – Completed daily by AHCCCS analysts
- Justice Liaisons from the ACC Health Plans notify AHCCCS
- Member notifies AHCCCS

*** All require verification from corrections facility

JUVENILES IN DETENTION

Current Process

- Currently, there is not an Enrollment Suspense IGA for juveniles in detention – This process is handled via manual notification from each county.
- In 2018, AHCCCS developed the **MCDU Justice Database** to create a single point of contact for juvenile detention facilities to submit notifications
- Standardized notification forms are sent to a designated email address.
- Service level = 1 business day from date of notification
