Child and Family Team

What is a Child and Family Team (CFT)?

When a child is receiving behavioral health services, a Child and Family Team collaboratively plans for services and supports that meet the child's unique needs to help them achieve positive outcomes.





Who is involved in a CFT?

The child and family determine who they want to be included in the team. At a minimum:

• Child, Parent (Guardian,) Behavioral Health Provider

CFT's can also include:

 Teachers, Coaches, Friends, Church, Division of Developmental Disabilities, Department of Child Safety, Department of Juvenile Justice, etc



What to Expect in a CFT

The CFT meeting allows the caregiver and professionals to formally discuss and consent to services, and have those services added to the child's service plan.

Covered services added to the service plan should be provided as **quickly as required by the child's needs** but initiated in no more than **45 days.**



For Children in the Care of the DCS:

A CFT meeting can occur even if the DCS Specialist is not available to attend in person or by phone.

Covered services added to the service plan are required to be provided within 21 days for children in the care of DCS. If you experience delays, please contact the Children's Services Liaison 602-453-8095.

If there is a safety concern or the child is at risk of experiencing a crisis, the team will create a crisis plan.

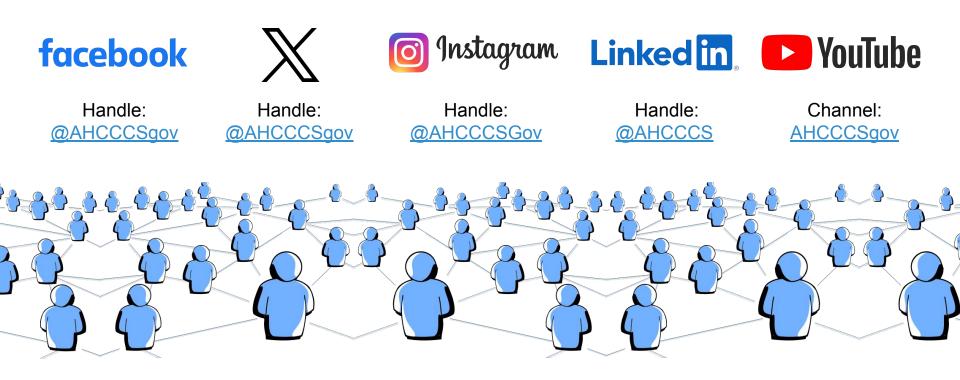
