

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION – FINAL PUBLIC NOTICE**

1. **Name of the Agency:** Arizona Health Care Cost Containment System (AHCCCS)

2. **The topic of the public information notice:**

AHCCCS Fee-For-Service (FFS) per diem rates for Nursing Facilities effective for dates of service on and after July 1, 2017.

3. **The public information relating to the topic:**

- a. This Notice describes changes to the Arizona Health Care Cost Containment System (AHCCCS) Fee-For-Service (FFS) per diem rates for Nursing Facilities effective for dates of service on and after July 1, 2017 to address the increased labor costs resulting from the Arizona minimum wage increase and employee benefit provisions mandated by Proposition 206, and the Flagstaff minimum wage increase mandated by Proposition 414 and later amended through action of the Flagstaff City Council. The total change in FFS payments as a result of the changes is an estimated increase of \$131,930 for the time period of July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018.
- b. AHCCCS' Managed Care Organizations are required to pass-through these rate increases effective with dates of service on and after July 1, 2017 to Nursing Facility providers.
- c. The AHCCCS Nursing Facility fee schedule has been updated as illustrated below:
