3. The public information relating to the topic:

This Notice of Public Information describes proposed changes to the Arizona Health Care Cost Containment System (AHCCCS) fee-for-service (FFS) reimbursement rates for emergency ambulance services provided by ground ambulance providers operating under a certificate of necessity issued by the Arizona Department of Health Services (ADHS). The proposed changes are required by Arizona statute and will apply only to emergency ground ambulance rates for ground ambulance providers whose rates are set by ADHS. The changes to rates will take effect for dates of service on and after October 1, 2015.

Pursuant to Arizona Laws 2015, Chapter 14, Section 3 (SB 1475), the new rates for emergency ground ambulance services for dates of service on and after October 1, 2015 will be set at 68.59% of the rates established on the July 1, 2015 Arizona Ground Ambulance Service Rate Schedule published by ADHS, Bureau of Emergency Medical Services. AHCCCS estimates that these changes in rates will result in a decrease of 4.5% in FFS payments to these ground ambulance providers for emergency ground ambulance services.
