Dr. Thompson – He wanted to share recent experiences where has had referral services denied due to the visit being telehealth. It was a commercial plan. Dr. Salek would like to see the coding details and recommends utilizing the statute as it is appropriate. This may need to be forwarded to DIFI for review.	
Dr. Dobrusin – He notes that there may be a possibility that there is health plan prior authorization protocol. He has not seen anything specific to telemedicine visit.

#### 5. Telehealth Best Practices Report Review

We merged the physical and behavioral health best practices subcommittees that included a wide range of committee members and a national renowned SME Dr. Krupinski to evaluate national best practice guidelines and published papers.

We reviewed if it was available publicity, current, if it was relevant after the pandemic,

We have asked the American Telemedicine Association as one best practice wasn't available in the public domain.

Dr. Dahl-Popolizio – recommends adding the Principles for Delivering Telerehabilitation Services. She is requesting since it includes reciprocity of other states, organizational guidelines that would be informative. -Need to double check that this is available publicly.

Dr. Goldberg notes the appreciation for this first round review.

Dr. Scott recommends adding the years to the documents. The group agrees.

Dr. Salek recommends the subcommittee to meet regularly to ensure the listing is correct.

Dr. Goldberg would like to meet every 6 months then move to annually. The group agrees that the subcommittee worked well and was efficient.
