¹An American Indian AHCCCS or KidsCare Member can switch between AIHP and ACC Plans at any time. In order to switch from one ACC health plan to another ACC health plan, the same guidelines for the general AHCCCS health plan member population must be followed. Members designated Seriously Mentally Ill (SMI) may receive physical and behavioral health services through a Regional Behavioral Health Authority (RBHA), or receive physical health services through ACC or AIHP, and behavioral health services through a RBHA or Tribal Regional Behavioral Health Authority (TRBHA).
