Overview of ASAM CONTINUUM’s Data Dictionary with Dr. Gastfriend:

- Is level 4 integration the right fit?
 - Level 4 is all response sets from the questions
 - 1,047 items could appear on the screen from the pool
- Option 1 would offer around 60 items
 - Provides the most compact information within columns
- Clinicians are receiving 2 reports
 - Narrative report and Summary report
 - Slide shown is what clinicians might view within EHR
 - Could also view pdf version of report
- Option 2: intermediate dataset
- Option 4 would provide everything
 - Would need multiple sub-menu tiers
 - Need to consider how EHR will handle 1,047 items

Comparison and Discussion Questions Relating to Existing Clinical Workflows:

- Terros: goal is to prevent double data entry
 - API would be used by Nextgen, not Terros
 - Terros does not want to rebuild language algorithms
- EHR contracts with ASAM directly, but organizations have the input



- What kind of data does AZ want the state to receive from ASAM/FEI?
- A trained BHT currently administering assessments around 60mins
