ASAM CONTINUUM™ Triage (CO-Triage™):

CO-Triage is a quick referral tool for substance use problems. The CO-Triage structured interview guides users in reviewing substance use problems, as well as major medical and psychological conditions, according to the ASAM Criteria Dimensions.

Use CO-Triage and quickly get the patient to the right place for comprehensive assessment:

In about 6 minutes, identify the best setting for the patient to undergo definitive addiction assessment and care planning.

Use CO-Triage to engage the patient and achieve better follow-through to care:

Even providers who are non-specialists in addiction can now interview and refer with an expert patient-centered and motivational approach.

Share CO-Triage Referral Reports to convey patient needs.

The CO-Triage report summarizes patient information and interviewer comments, structured along the six ASAM Criteria Dimensions for a clear perspective on the patient's overall needs. When you assess with CO-Triage and send the referral Report, clinicians at the receiving program will have an immediate understanding of key problems, needs, and resources. This can allow treatment to start much sooner.

Designed for non-medical and medical settings

CO-Triage is appropriate for clinicians, first responders, EMTs, recovery support service staff, and other non-clinicians who are trained and supervised by an addiction speciality clinician.

Non-addiction clinical settings

Primary care, emergency rooms, urgent care centers, medical homes, etc.

Non-clinical settings

Call-in/ referral centers, care navigators, employment assistant programs, justice systems (courts, jails, law enforcement), etc.

Specialty addiction settings

Addiction treatment as a preliminary intake assessment used prior to a full assessment.

Note: CO-Triage is not designed to be used in a specialty addiction treatment center as a placement tool.
