Offeror described the geographic and social challenges within the GSA and approaches for addressing issues.

Offeror described experience and/or approaches to enhance access for an array of services throughout the GSA, including the expansion of services to Colorado City, expansion of telemedicine, increasing the number of female OB/Gyn. physicians, expansion of access to ESRD, cancer and ASD treatment services, expansion of paramedicine model, expansion of crisis services and enhancing access to technology solutions and phones, but Offeror did not address lack of connectivity in the North GSA.

Offeror comprehensively described social and cultural characteristics in the North GSA and approaches to address these issues, including social support services.

Offeror described provider shortage areas by specialty and identified underserved areas.

Offeror described several approaches for addressing service needs of the community, including use of promotoras to mirror linguistic and cultural preferences of community served, tuition reimbursement for healthcare education, specialty telehealth, Health Homes, PCP screening, use of border state providers and crisis services.

Offeror generally described the physician shortage issue in the North GSA.

Offeror described its approach to address service shortages, including development of member and provider incentives for PCP visits, incentives to enhance access and coordination activities to enhance access.

Offeror described social and cultural characteristics in the North GSA and specific approaches to address these issues, including financial grants for social programs, community education programs, outreach via radio and enhancement of internet connectivity.

Offeror described approach to partner with Northern Arizona to develop home grown providers and promote residency program.

Offeror described social and cultural characteristics in the North GSA and approaches to address these issues, including cultural competency training, education regarding historical trauma and deployment of staff in the Region.

Offeror generally described social and cultural characteristics in the North GSA and development of Advisory Councils to develop tailored approaches.
