

If you are a TI Pediatric Behavioral Health participant provider and would like to have your staff trained to use the Early Child Service Intensity Instrument (ECSII) to treat children 0-5 for trauma, please see the list below of trainers that can provide that service.

Important considerations for the ECSII Training:

- This option to train others has a deadline of June 30, 2019.
- Training can take place agency to agency – individuals cannot train or represent themselves as an individual trainer in any way
- Training will be for utilizers only. This is not a train the trainer situation.
- Users must acknowledge and agree that AACAP (American Academy of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry) owns all Intellectual Property Rights for any content contained within the ECSII manual and any other training materials. No part of the manual may be reproduced without written permission.
- Only “trained trainers” that participated in the initial ECSII training held from June 20th, 2018 through June 22, 2018 may train other users that work within organizations falling under AHCCCS, through May 31st, 2019. No one may train others outside these parameters or after June 1st, 2019.
- Trained trainers will not conduct any instrument trainings to organizations outside AHCCCS, or they will be held liable for contract infringement.
- Trained trainers will share records of all individuals that are trained, with the Arizona Foundation for Human Service Providers and/or AHCCCS on a monthly basis.
- Instructions may not be video/audio taped without prior permission from AACAP.
