TI 2.0 KICK-OFF MEETING

Targeted Investments (TI 2.0) Program participants will be required to attend the in-person TI 2.0 Program Kick-Off Meeting on Monday, February 5, 2024 from 9:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m. at the ASU Memorial Union building (301 E Orange St., Tempe, AZ 85281).

AHCCCS requires at least one representative (no more than two) from each organization (per tax ID) to attend this session in-person to earn the full Year 2 payment. Failure to meet this requirement will reduce payment by 5%. Organizations may designate anyone from their organization to attend, but it is recommended that attendees should have administrative or clinical authority on behalf of the organization. These individuals could be TI project managers, executive management, clinical leadership, etc. The attendees should be individuals who will be actively informed and engaged in their organization's TI 2.0 Program performance.

The deadline to register for the kick-off meeting is Monday, January 29, 2024. Additional event and logistics details (e.g., parking) will be communicated in the upcoming weeks. Organizations may contact the ASU TIPQIC team with questions at TIPQIC@asu.edu.

TI 2.0 CONTACT INFORMATION FORM

All participating organizations must complete the TI Contact Information Form by Monday January 29, 2024. Participants are responsible for using the form to make updates as team members change. The form collects up to four individuals' names, emails, and phone numbers for each of the four categories of contacts:

- Authorized User(s): Individual(s) who will be responsible for the accuracy of each attestation and serves as the primary point of contact for payment-related information and post-pay audits.
- Project Manager(s): Individual(s) who are responsible for TI program related logistics and communications. They serve as the main point of contact for the TI Program at their organization.
- Billing & Credentialing Contact(s): Individual(s) who are responsible for their organization's AHCCCS Provider Enrollment.
- · General Contact(s): Additional Individuals who want to stay up to date with their organization's participation in the TI Program. Communication is limited to TI program news and performance updates.
