- There are 2 new providers effective 10-1-15: Health Choice Integrated Care (HCIC) and Cenpatico Integrated Care (C-IC).
- The agency updated geographical service areas, approximately 6,000 members changed from Gila County to Graham County. The updates were phased in during August, September and October 2015.
- The agency refined a section of system logic which resulted in population shifts. There was movement from SSI Expanded to SSI Related and 1931-Regular to 1931-Expanded.
- From July 1st, 2016 to August 1st, 2016, the population increased 15,621 members or 1%.
- The major increases in the AHCCCS population from July 1st, 2016 to August 1st, 2016 were:
 - 5,088 SOBRA Child
 - 5,001 Transitional Medical Assistance (TMA)
 - 4,185 Prop 204 Restoration
 - 1,661 1931 AHCCCS for Families & Children
- The major decrease in the AHCCCS population from July 1st, 2016 to August 1st, 2016 was:
 - 2,115 SOBRA Pregnant
- Young Adult Transitional Insurance (YATI) population:
