- The freeze was removed from KidsCare. Applications were accepted starting July 26, 2016 for coverage that would begin September 1, 2016.
- From August 1st, 2016 to September 1st, 2016, the population increased 18,259 members or 1%.
- The major increases in the AHCCCS population from August 1st, 2016 to September 1st, 2016 were:
 - 6,916 SOBRA Child
 - 2,369 Transitional Medical Assistance (TMA)
 - 2,291 KidsCare
 - 2,099 1931 AHCCCS for Families & Children
 - 1,666 Prop 204 Restoration
- There were no significant decreases in the AHCCCS population from August 1st, 2016 to September 1st, 2016
- Young Adult Transitional Insurance (YATI) population:
