From November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020 to December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020 the population increased\* 18,936 members or 1%.

The major increases in the AHCCCS population from November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020 to December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020 were:

- 6,510 Adult Expansion
- 4,612 SOBRA Child
- 3,915 Prop 204 Restoration
- 1,689 SSI Related
- 1,679 AHCCCS for Families & Children
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There were no major decreases in the AHCCCS population from November 1<sup>st</sup> 2020 to December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020.
