The major increases in the AHCCCS population from September 1st, 2020 to October 1st, 2020 were:

- 7,742 Adult Expansion
- 2,345 SOBRA Child
- 1,911 Prop 204 Restoration
- 1,809 Transitional Medical Assistance
- 1,346 SSI Related

There were no major decreases in the AHCCCS population from September 1st 2020 to October 1st, 2020.
