From April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021 to May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021 the population increased\* 16,991 members or 1%.

The major increases in the AHCCCS population from April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021 to May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021 were:

- 6,802 Prop 204 Restoration
- 2,225 SOBRA Child
- 1,420 Adult Expansion
- 1,392 AHCCCS for Families & Children
- 1,362 KidsCare

There were no major decreases in the AHCCCS population from April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021 to May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021.
