From March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022 to April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022 the population increased\* 11,288 members or less than 1%.

\*Population increase due to activity resulting from the Families First Coronavirus Response Act.

The major increases in the AHCCCS population from March 1st, 2022 to April 1st, 2022 were:

- 5,694 Prop 204 Restoration (0 – 100% FPL)
- 2,470 Transitional Medical Assistance (TMA)
- 988 Emergency Services
- 848 SOBRA Child
- 838 KidsCare

The major decreases in the AHCCCS population from March 1st, 2022 to April 1st, 2022 were:

- 828 Adult Expansion (100%-133% FPL)
- 695 SOBRA Pregnant
