From March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023, to April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023, the population decreased 35,107 members or 1%.

The major increases in the AHCCCS population from March 1st, 2023, to April 1st, 2023, were:

- 976 SLMB
- 940 QI – 1
- 658 AHCCCS for Families & Children

The major decreases in the AHCCCS population from March 1st, 2022, to April 1st, 2023, were:

- 15,220 Transitional Medical Assistance (TMA)
- 10,138 Adult Expansion
- 5,838 SOBRA Child
- 1,745 Prop 204 Restoration
- 1,471 KidsCare
