From February 1, 2024, to March 1, 2024, the population increased by 9,826 members, or less than 1%.

The major increases in the AHCCCS population from February 1, 2024, to March 1, 2024, were:

- 5,640 Transitional Medical Assistance (TMA)
- 3,058 SOBRA Child
- 1,139 Adult Expansion
- 895 KidsCare

The major decrease in the AHCCCS population from February 1, 2024, to March 1, 2024, was:

- 3,679 AHCCCS for Families & Children
