From September 1, 2025, to October 1, 2025, the population decreased by 19,109 members, or 1%.

There were no major increases in the AHCCCS population from September 1, 2025, to October 1, 2025.

- 4,327 SOBRA Child
- 3,288 1931 AHCCCS for Families & Children
- 3,212 Prop 204 Restoration (0 100% FPL)
- 888 SOBRA Pregnant
- 548 Adult Expansion (100% 133% FPL)
