AHCCCS MEDICAL POLICY MANUAL (AMPM)

Pursuant to Laws 2019, 1st Regular Session, Chapter 305, behavioral health services for children in DCS custody were anticipated to transition from the RBHA Contractors to DCS/ CMDP effective October 1, 2020. However, this implementation has been delayed. Revisions that have already been completed for ACOM and AMPM Policies and Attachment(s), related to this anticipated integration **[listed in document provided below]**, will remain in the impacted policies but will not be applicable until such time that CMDP behavioral health service integration is implemented. Revisions unrelated to the integration of behavioral health services for CMDP members; will continue to be effective October 1, 2020.

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#### AMPM Policy 320-W, THERAPEUTIC FOSTER CARE FOR CHILDREN

AMPM 320-W is a new Policy that establishes requirements regarding Therapeutic Foster Care (TFC) for Children. The draft policy that was sent out for public comment included Adult Behavioral Health Therapeutic Homes (ABHTH) and based on public feedback, AHCCCS has determined to create a separate Adult Behavioral Health Therapeutic Homes (ABHTH) Policy that is currently under development. *Implementation Date 10/01/20.* 

### POST TRIBAL CONSULTATION NOTIFICATION/PUBLIC COMMENT CHANGES:

AMPM Policy 320-W was revised for removal of adult system specific language, removal of Department of Child Safety (DCS) specific language, and clarification between Individualized Service Plan (ISP) and Therapeutic Foster Care (TFC) Treatment Plan after being posted for Tribal Consultation Notification/Public Comment on 04/16/20.
