### **INFORMATION REGARDING COVID-19**

In response to Medicaid-related questions from providers and contractors arising from the COVID-19 pandemic, AHCCCS has developed a list of Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) Regarding Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) which is updated regularly. It is important to note that there are instances where the information presented in the CMS-approved flexibilities and COVID-19 FAQs does not align with provisions set forth by the AHCCCS Medical Policy Manual (AMPM). In these instances, the CMS-approved flexibilities and FAQs take precedence and are controlling.

### Name Change

Effective April 1, 2021 Comprehensive Medical and Dental Program (CMDP) will be changing to Comprehensive Health Plan (CHP) due to Behavioral health integration. Refer to Laws 2019, 1<sup>st</sup> Regular Session. AHCCCS is in the process of revising all pertinent documents to reflect the new name.

## AMPM Policy 320-T1 - BLOCK GRANTS AND DISCRETIONARY GRANTS

AMPM Policy 320-T1 has been revised to reflect a July 1, 2020 retroactive updates for Mental Health Block Grant Funds for payment of behavioral health drugs for individuals designated as SMI (Both Title XIX/XXI and Non-Title XIX/XXI). Additionally, language was moved from ACOM Policy 201 Medicare Cost Sharing for members Covered by Medicare and Medicaid. Added clarification language to ensure the Contractor's Pharmacy Benefit Management (PBM) plan parameters do not interfere with the coordination of benefits of the Medicare Part D prescription (Rx) Claim. Also, changing from behavioral health medications to medications to



treat behavioral health diagnoses so that medications which are not a psychotropic medication are included for pharmacy coordination of payment. For example, a medication to treat an extrapyramidal side effect (EPS) is not a psychotropic but is used to treat the side effect of the behavioral health medication causing the EPS.

Policy 320-T1 has a retroactive effective date of 07/01/20.

# AMPM Policy 320-T2 - Non-Title XIX/XXI Services and Funding (Excluding Block Grants and Discretionary Grants)

AMPM Policy 320-T2 has been revised to reflect 07/01/20 retroactive updates for funding sources for copayments and cost sharing of behavioral health drugs for individuals designated with a Serious Mental Illness (both Title XIX/XXI and Non-Title XIX/XXI). Language from ACOM 201 Medicare Cost Sharing for members Covered by Medicare and Medicaid was moved into AMPM Policy 320-T2 to add clarification language to ensure Managed Care Organization (MCO) Pharmacy Benefit Manager (PBM) plan parameters do not interfere with the Coordination of Benefits (COB) of the Medicare Part D Rx Claim. Also, changing from behavioral health medications to medications to treat behavioral health diagnoses so that medications which are not a psychotropic medication are included for pharmacy coordination of payment. For example, a medication to treat an Extrapyramidal Side effect (EPS) is not a psychotropic but is used to treat the side effect of the behavioral health medication causing the EPS. *Policy has a retroactive effective date of 07/01/20*.
