SECTION 504 OF THE REHABILITATION ACT

Effective May 1, 2024, The Office for Civil Rights (OCR) finalized the rule that prohibits discrimination on the basis of disability. AHCCCS is in the process of revising all pertinent documents to remove symbols and periods from various Federal and State citations to ensure accessibility for all individuals in compliance with [Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act](#).

AHCCCS NEW AGENCY STRUCTURE

Effective March 3, 2025, AHCCCS unveiled a new Agency structure. AHCCCS is in the process of revising all pertinent documents to reflect the new Division titles. CURRENT UPDATES AND REVISIONS TO THE AHCCCS MEDICAL POLICY MANUAL (AMPM)
NEWLY ADDED TO APPROVED NOT YET EFFECTIVE

430 - EARLY AND PERIODIC SCREENING, DIAGNOSTIC, AND TREATMENT SERVICES

Implementation date 10/01/26

AMPM Policy 430 had substantial changes below that included but were not limited to:

- Replacing “Medicaid Act” with the social security act to reflect current terminology.
- Updating documentation requirements for behavioral health screening.
- Adding depression to adolescent suicide screening for consistency.
- Revising newborn hearing timelines and follow up expectations to align with state law and national best practices to ensure children with hearing loss receive timely diagnosis and intervention services.
- Adding language that member outreach shall comply with ACOM Policy 404.
- Deleting duplicative statement regarding Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnostic, and Treatment Services (EPSDT) oral health outreach requirements.
- Adding requirement to use AHCCCS Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnostic, and Treatment Services (EPSDT) Clinical Sample Templates (Attachment E) or an equivalent form approved by the contracted health plan and monitor providers use.
- Adding AMPM Policy 430 Attachment C for reference under the PCP contract language requirements.
- Adding AMPM Policy 580 for reference to the 12 principles.
- Revising Notice of Action (NOA) to Notice of Adverse Benefit Determination (NABD) throughout Policy.

ATTACHMENT A – AHCCCS EARLY AND PERIODIC SCREENING, DIAGNOSTIC AND TREATMENT PERIODICITY SCHEDULE

Implementation date 10/01/26

Attachment A had substantial changes below that included but were not limited to:

- Making alignments with the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) Bright Futures periodicity schedule for dyslipidemia and fluoride varnish.
- Revising the adolescent suicide screening to include depression screening.
- Replacing newborn metabolic screening with newborn bloodspot to be reflective of all the conditions screened for.
- Revising newborn hearing screening timelines and bloodspot testing to align with state law.

POST PUBLIC COMMENT CHANGE

- Removing Cervical Dysplasia Screening to align with American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists (ACOG) guidelines for screening which starts at 21 years of age.

- Adding lipid profile to align with the AHCCCS Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnostic, and Treatment Services (EPSDT) periodicity schedule, which shall occur once between 9-11 years and 17-20 years of age.
